APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) offers work experience, teaches valuable employment skills, and provides you with a summer income. SYEP educational activities will enhance your summer experience, allowing you to develop career awareness, understanding of personal money management, and work-related social skills.

SYEP is open to all New York City residents between ages 14 through 24, as of July 6 2010.

Each applicant may submit only one application.

To apply for SYEP:

- Visit www.nyc.gov/dycd and complete the application online.

OR

- Complete the attached application and return it in person to the community-based SYEP provider of your choice (a list of organizations throughout the City is attached). Do NOT mail in your application to DYCD or the SYEP Provider.

The DEADLINE for submitting your application is **Friday, May 21, 2010.**

SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION DOES NOT GUARANTEE ELIGIBILITY OR ENROLLMENT INTO THE PROGRAM.

If you are selected for SYEP you will be notified by the SYEP provider to which you submitted your application and asked to submit additional documentation immediately (see attached *Required Documents Checklist*)

Failure to submit required documentation as instructed will make you ineligible to participate in SYEP.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS CHECKLIST

In order to be placed in a summer job, you will need to bring certain documents to your SYEP provider. You must submit COPIES of one (1) item from categories 1-9 listed below as it applies to you. These items are needed to officially complete your enrollment so that you are eligible for an SYEP job. Note that some documents may satisfy more than one category (e.g. U.S. Birth Certificate or current U.S. Passport for categories 1 and 4).

1. Proof of Age

- Birth Certificate **OR**
- Benefit Card **OR**
- NYS Driver/Non-Driver's License **OR**
- Alien Registration Card **OR**
- Valid U.S. Passport

2. Proof of Social Security Number

- Social Security Card (*ONLY*)

3. Working Papers (*Must be age applicable*)

If you are under the age of 18 at the time of application, you must submit your most current working papers. Working papers can be acquired through your school. If you are not attending school, call 311 or contact your local public high school.

- 14 and 15 years of age: Blue Card
- 16 and 17 years of age: Green Card

4. Proof of Citizenship/Alien Status

- Valid U.S. Passport **OR**
- U.S. Birth Certificate **OR**
- Alien Registration Card **OR**
- I-94 , I-551, I-688B, I-766 **OR**
- Certificate of Naturalization **OR**
- Employment Registration Card

5. Proof of Address (*Dated within the last 6 months*)

- Home Utility Bill **OR**
- Current Lease **OR**
- Official Mail from a Federal, State or City Agency

6. Proof of Family Income
(Dated within the last 6 months)

- If Supported by Public Assistance***
- Current EBT Card (with parent/guardian name) **AND** a recent store receipt **OR**
- Current Benefit Budget Letter **OR**
- Official letter from Social Services (Must include applicant's name, Benefit # and date)

OR

- If Not Supported by Public Assistance***
- Two (2) consecutive pay stubs dated within the last six months (*Must include payee name, and gross income*) **OR**
- 2009 W-2 form and one (1) pay stub dated within the last six months **OR**
- Current Pension Award letter **OR**
- Current SSA Award letter **OR**
- Unemployment Benefit Document dated within the last six months **OR**
- If self employed, 2009 Tax Return including Schedule "C" or "E" (if receiving rental income)

7. SYEP Application

- A signed SYEP application is required for all youth. Youth under the age of 18 are required to have the signature of a parent or guardian.

Please provide ONLY if applicable

8. Selective Service Registration Card **OR**

- Selective Service "Online Receipt"
Required for males 18 years of age or older

9. Proof of Disability: Official documentation as applicable certifying disability from a physician, ACS, HRA, School, Social Service agency or authorized entity.
